

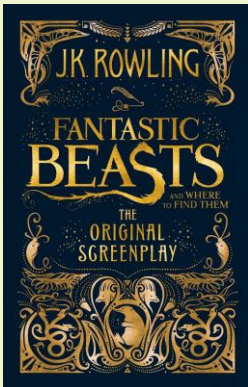

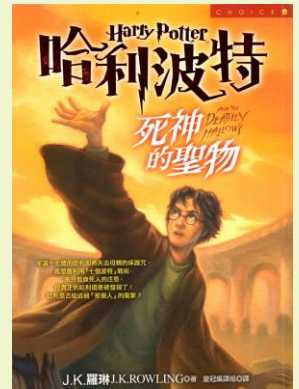
Fantastic Beasts and Where to Find Them: The Original Screenplay

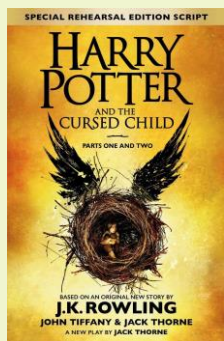
