

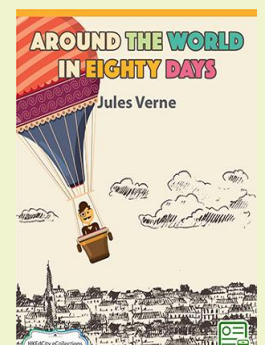

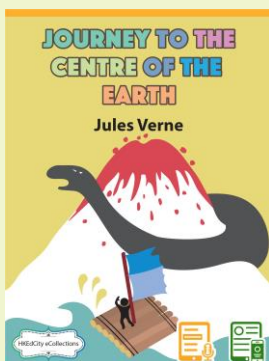
## 《Around the World in Eighty Days》

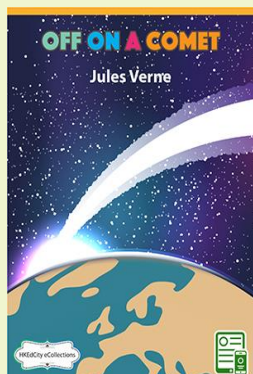
